Wifi

Hot Water

There is a full tank of hot water every morning. If you run out of hot water during the day there is a booster switch upstairs which you can use to get more hot water.

Heating

Fuel is provided for the fire. There are instructions for operating the stove left on the mantelpiece.

Please be aware that the stove and handle get hot, use the glove provided.

You can buy more fuel at Lidl or Aldi or at Sweeney Oil Service Station on the way into Clifden. The electric heaters are set on a timer. If you feel these need adjusting please let us know. There are also extra plug-in heaters.

Rubbish

On leaving please leave rubbish in the bins provided outside. There are two bins outside, one for recyclables (clean & dry) and the other for non-recyclable/general rubbish. Please bring glass bottles, drink cans and food tins to the recycling banks. You will find the recycling banks on the way into Clifden on the left hand side of the road (before Clifden Industrial Park).

Pets

Pets are allowed but please keep dogs under control as there are sheep in the fields surrounding the house.

Gates

You are welcome to explore the area around the cottage. If out walking in the fields make sure to close all gates behind you.

Other notes

The water from the tap is fine for drinking.

No smoking inside the cottage.

No parties.

Your departure

Check-out is by 11am on your day of departure.

Due to Covid-19 we ask that guests strip the beds and leave linen in a bundle for collection.

Used towels can be left in a pile in the bathroom.

Please ensure all rubbish is left in the correct bins for disposal and tidied neatly.

Glass bottles and jars should be taken away and brought to the bottle banks.

On check out please leave the key in the lockbox.
