Wifi

Hot Water

There is a full tank of hot water every morning. If you run out of hot water during the day there is a booster switch beside the kitchen sink which you can use to get more hot water.

Heating

There is a solid fuel stove in the sitting room. Wood is provided for the fire and there is also extra wood in the shed. If you need to get more fuel you can buy it in the supermarkets in Tully or Letterfrack village. Please see the instructions in the folder for operating the stove to use it efficiently. The electric heaters are set on a timer. If you feel these need adjusting let us know.

Rubbish

Please separate rubbish in the 3 bins provided:

- recyclables (clean & dry)
- non-recyclable/general rubbish
- compostable waste

On leaving, general and recycling rubbish can be left in the two bins provided in the shed.

Please do not put glass in the bins. Bring glass bottles and drinks cans to the recycling banks which you'll find in Tully and Letterfrack villages and at Lettergesh Caravan Park.

The compost bin can be emptied in the pit at the bottom of the garden.

There is a metal bin in the shed for ashes from the fire (can also be emptied in the pit).

TV/Books/Games

For entertainment there is a TV, DVDs and Xbox games console with games. There is also a good selection of books and some board games.

Pets

Pets are allowed but keep dogs under control as there are sometimes sheep and cattle in the fields surrounding the house.

Laundry

There is a washing machine and clothes dryer in the shed for your use.

Outdoor Furniture/BBQ

The BBQ and garden furniture in the shed are also for your use. Please put them back in the shed after using.

Supplies

For food shopping there are small supermarkets in Tully and Letterfrack. Larger shops can be found in Clifden town (Lidl, Aldi & Supervalu). You will also find craft shops, art galleries and some clothes shops in Clifden.

Other notes

The water from the tap is fine for drinking.

Extra quilts for the beds are provided and there are extra blankets in the drawers upstairs.

No smoking inside the cottage.

No parties.

Your departure

Check-out is by 12pm on the day of your departure.

Due to Covid-19 we ask that guests strip the used beds and leave linen in a bundle for collection. Used towels can be left in a pile in the bathroom.

Please ensure all rubbish is left in the correct bins for disposal and tidied neatly.

Glass bottles, jars and tin cans should be taken away and brought to the bottle banks.

On check-out please leave the key in the lockbox.
